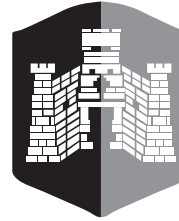

MYTH:

This is an attempt to overturn the election.

FACT:

The basis for the recall centered on our Constitutional rights and during this process it became apparent the four councilors, who are the subject of the recall, have continued to be dismissive of their abuses. They ignore their duties of governance concerning the recall as they have done regarding citizens' rights. They slander the recall process as political-advocacy from outside interests. Nothing is further from the truth. Their claim is frivolous and factually incorrect. If there is any veracity to their claims, they would have produced the necessary proof and put a stop to the recall as permitted by law. The 3 councilors to be placed into office in accordance with the Exeter town charter were narrowly defeated by .001% - .04% of the electorate. By contrast, that election result is well below the 12% which signed the recall petition, indicative of the significant consent of fellow citizens to the recall. We did not choose the mechanism of a recall. Ironically, the councilor who has complained most vociferously about the arbitrary character of the recall provision helped write the charter!
